Constitution of Indian Association of Veterinary Anatomists

1. i)Name	The name of the Association is "Indian Association of Veterinary Anatomists", referred to hereunder as the "Association" or "IAVA".
ii)Aims and Objects	The aims and objects of the Association are defined as under:-
	a) Promotion and advancement of Veterinary Anatomy, including all its branches such as Gross Anatomy, Histology, Cytology, Histochemistry, Developmental Anatomy, Neuroanatomy, Applied and Surgical anatomy etc.; as it relates to all vertebrates, with special emphasis on animals of Veterinary (domestic and wild life) importance.
	b) Encouragement and stimulation to research, education, extension, popularization of Veterinary Anatomy and to promote better understanding of Biological structure of organisms stated under a) above.
	c) Establishment of high and uniform standards of Veterinary Anatomy at proper position in educational programmes at all places of teaching and research of Veterinary and Animal Sciences in India. To achieve this, to recommend to all teaching, research and extension institutions, on all appropriate matters concerning Anatomy at all levels.
	d) Recommend and ensure allocation of a certain percentage of posts, funds and facilities specifically for teaching and research in Veterinary Anatomy at all Universities and Colleges.
	e) Encouragement to fraternity, mutual co-operation and scientific exchange amongst Veterinary Anatomists by way of Publications, symposia, seminars, workshops, exchange visits, meetings etc.
	f) Protection of professional rights and interests of its members in respect of career and related opportunities. To uphold the honour and dignity of its members.
	g) Encourage the cause of progress and betterment of Veterinary Anatomy and Veterinary Anatomists in India and the world and to strengthen the bridge between Veterinary Anatomists.
2. Address of the Association and its Jurisdiction:	The effective jurisdiction of the Association is geographical territory of the Indian Union as defined by the "Constitution of India". Membership of the Association however is open to any person irrespective of the citizenship or geographical location of the person. The location of office of the Association will be the address of Secretary of the Association at the particular time.

3. Membership:	The Association consists of members who being eligible, applied in prescribed form (Appendix-A)* for membership** and were duly accepted as members. Except in case of Life Members, every other kind of membership will be for a specific period of time and may be renewed for a further specific period of time.

5. Membership of managing Committee:	All these members will be elected by the General Body of IAVA through an election organized by the Election Committee. The term of office of each member of the Executive Committee in one or the other position, would be of 3 years in total. If elections cannot be held for unavoidable circumstances the existing Executive Committee will continue to function in a caretaker capacity. Members who retire from membership of the Executive Committee are eligible for re- election provided no member holds the office for more than two terms or 6 years.
6. General Body Meetings:	General Body: All members, of all categories constitute the General Body of IAVA. The General Body should ordinarily meet once every year but must meet at least once in three years, anywhere in India but not in the same state on two consecutive occasions. The General Body Meeting will be chaired by the President of the Association and by the Vice-President if the President is not present. In case when both of these officers are absent, the Chairman will be elected by the majority of members attending the meeting.

6(i).Editorial Board:	 The IAVA will publish a scientific journal entitled Indian Journal of Veterinary Anatomy and the responsibility to edit and publish the journal will rest with editorial Board which will consist of the following members. i. Chairman:- President of IAVA (Ex-Officio) ii. Executive Editor:- One * iii. Associate Editor:- One* iv. Members of Editorial Board:- Five * The Executive Editor and five members of the board will be proposed by the Executive Council of IAVA and approved by the General Body. 7. Quorum of the Meetings: 8. Notice of the Meetings:	At least 2/3 of the total registered members of paid categories will constitute quorum for the General Body Meeting. In the absence of this quorum, meeting will be adjourned for half an hour and then meet without requirement of quorum. No General Body Meeting in which 2/3 members are not present will be able to decide issues for which 2/3 majority is mandatory under constitution. Nonpaying members i.e. Patrons and Affiliated Members will not be eligible to vote on any resolution in the meeting. In case when the vote is equal, the chairman of the meeting has the casting vote, which he may or may not exercise, in addition to his normal vote. The General Body meeting will be called by a written notice issued with the signature of President and Secretary of IAVA. A clear notice
	of 30 days is required and the date on the postal certificate of posting of notice would be taken to calculate the period.

	ii. The Association will collect as subscription or price of its publications and also advertisement fee from advertisers.
	 iii. IAVA will accept grant-in-aid, subsidy endowment, gifts, donations etc. from any Government Associations Organizations, Commercial enterprises, Public or private trusts etc. given for the purpose of helping the aims and objects of the association.
	iv. The Association will accept contributions, donations, rents, privilege fee, franchise fee etc. from any source as long as such funds are in line with its aims and objectives and are paid legally for the benefit of the association and not to any individual.
	v. All income and assets of the association will be used solely for the purposes of the association. No remuneration will be paid to any member or office bearer of the association except for some specific services such as secretarial or accounts work rendered by and specifically authorized on travel or other petty expenditure to attend official meetings or in respect of official work of association will be reimbursed from the funds of the association.
12.Accounting Year:	The Gregorian Christian calendar i.e. 1 st January to 31 st December shall be the accounting year of the Association.
13.Power and Duties of Office Be	arers:
i. The President:	a).He / She will act as Chair person at all meetings of General Body and Executive Committee and any other Committee of which he is a member.
	b)He / She will guide, supervise and control all activities of the Association.

ii. The Vice-president	He / She shall discharge all, responsibilities of the President in the absence of the President due to resignation illness or death and when ever President is otherwise unable to discharge his responsibility physically.
iii. The Secretary	a) He / She will be incharge of the office of the Association and will conduct all correspondence
	b) Shall convene meetings of General Body and all committees of the Association. Maintain minutes of all meetings and keep

	correct and up to data rolls of members
	correct and up to date rolls of members.
	c) Shall be responsible for all property and documents belonging to the Association and will maintain them properly. Secretary is responsible to present a document, to the Executive Committee for inspection at one week notice. It will be the responsibility of the Secretary to hand over physically all property and documents to his successor within 2 weeks of election of successor.
iv. Treasurer:	 a. Receive money, pass receipts, maintain bank account, transact business with banks and other commercial establishments, maintain accounts, get accounts audited from authorized external auditors and present the statement of account, audited balance sheets and budgets to the General Body Meeting.
	 b. Treasurer is authorized to spend an amount of up to Rs. 250/- at time in the interest of the Association's aims and objectives without prior permission of the Executive Committee. He / She must however obtain either advance or post facto sanction from Executive Committee for all expenditure.
	 c. Treasurer of IAVA jointly with the secretary is authorized to maintain account with cheque book facility with one or more banks, in the name of Indian Association of Veterinary Anatomists and the Treasurer will however have an authority to issue a cheque for an amount not exceeding Rs. 250/- at a time.
	d. He / She will be responsible and answerable to the Executive Committee and will discharge duties and responsibilities assigned to him.
v. The Joint Secretary:	He / She will, assist the Secretary in discharge of his/her responsibility.
14.Bank Account:	One or more bank accounts in title Name of the Association may be opened in one or more nationalized or Co-operative banks and/or post offices as required. These accounts will be opened, operated and closed jointly by the Secretary and Treasurer jointly on behalf of the Association. While handing over the charge to successor, the Treasurer must close such accounts, if necessary and transfer the balance amount to his successor. In case of death of the Secretary or Treasurer, the accounts will remain frozen until the successor is elected .On a official letter signed by the President of the Association and the newly appointed Secretary and Treasurer, the frozen accounts will be released and become operational in the name of the new Secretary and Treasurer.
15.Amendments:	Any amendment to these Rules and Regulations shall be passed by 2/3 majority decision of the General Body as per provisions of Section 12 of the Society Registration Act, 1860.

16.Dissolution:	The Association shall be dissolved by the majority decision of 3/5 of the members or the General Body as per provisions of the Section 13 and 14 of the Society Registration Act, 1860.
17.	A list of persons who are members of the Association with the meaning of Section 15 of Societies Registration Act, 1860 will be maintained in the form Schedule VI to the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) Rules 1971 vide rule 6 thereof.
18.	If a change is desired the name or objects of the Association or amalgamation of two or more societies is desired, procedure prescribed in Section 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 will be followed
