About University and College

The Nanaji Deshmukh Veterinary Science University Jabalpur was established on 3rd November, 2009. The university has three constituent Veterinary Colleges located at Jabalpur, Mhow, Rewa, Fishery College, Animal Biotechnology Center and School of Wild Life Forensic and Health at Jabalpur. Government and Private Veterinary polytechnic colleges are also affiliated with the University.



College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry was established on 8th July, 1948 under the Central Province and Berar. The college possesses 17 departments and two livestock farms. It has vast wisdom and legacy in terms of alumni in administrative service officers, IAS, IPS, IRS, IFS, RVC officers, Scientists etc. The founder president of IAVA, Dr. A.M. Shrivastava was also the alumni of this college. College campus is a vast land area of about 27 acres at the prestigious location of Jabalpur. It is one of the premier institutes for Veterinary Science education in central India.

About Department

The Department of Veterinary Anatomy was established in 1948, with the foundation of College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry. The department is offering M.V.Sc. in Veterinary Anatomy from 1964 and Ph.D. from 2008 and conducted research on gross, histological and histochemical aspects of different systems of domestic, wild and laboratory animals. Research findings were published in



national and international repute journals. The Department has a well established museum with skeletons, wet and dry specimens of domestic and wild animals and birds. Two extramural research projects of the department are "Establishment of Laboratory for Embalming of Ethically sourced Animals and Museum up Gradation" (budget 107.53 lakh) funded by MANDI, board Bhopal and "Anatomical and Radiographic study on Freshwater Turtles of M.P. regions" (Budget 10.30 lakh) funded by Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Madhya Pradesh (CAMPA), Bhopal. The department has organized an annual convention of IAVA and National symposium in 2006. Department is organizing regular skill based training for students of science stream. Faculty of the department has received many prestigious national and international awards.

Venue and Location

Jabalpur city named after its founder Rishi 'Jabali' and given the title of 'Sanskardhani' by Acharya Vinobha Bhave. The city is situated near the holy river Narmada. The awesome Bhedaghat (marble rocks), spectacular Dhuandhar and historical Madan Mahal attract tourists to the city. The host institute, College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry is located half kilometer away from the main railway station and 12 km from the airport. Weather remains pleasant during October month. Jabalpur is surrounded by famous National Park and Tiger Reserve, Kanha (125km), Pench (160km) and Bhandhavgarh (170km). Pachmarhi; — the summer capital of the state and alluring Khajuraho are also at a distance of 200km and 250km respectively from Jabalpur. Trips to these destinations can be arranged for delegates on prior intimation and advance payment.
