CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts for oral or poster presentations related to the congress theme along with submission form must be submitted by mail to aavacon2026@gmail.com, no later than 30th April 2026.

Guidelines for Abstract:

- TITLE: In sentence case, such that the first letter should be capitalized and all other letters should be texted by lower case.
- AUTHOR'S NAME(S): First name, middle name initial, and last name. Do not use any title (e.g., Dr.) or degrees (e.g., PhD). Maximum number of authors is six (6). Affix an asterisk (*) to the name of the presenter, and a plus sign (+) to the author for correspondence.
- AFFILIATION: Indicate the location where the author conducted the research, or to where the paper should be attributed [Department, Institution, Zip code, City, Province or State, Country]. The complete postal and email addresses of the author to whom correspondence should be addressed should be written below the author's name. Use superscripts to indicate author and corresponding address.
- The abstract must represent the content of all the main sections of the paper, stated between 300-500 words only and should not contain figures, tables, and references to the literature. Write up to five (5) key words, in alphabetical order.
- Poster should be in A0 size (~84 x 119 cm) at portrait format-orientation, with a 38 mm border all around.
- Use Times New Roman font, with the following font sizes: 150 pt for title, 120 pt for authors; 32 pt for headings; 18 pt for text. Use white background only.
- Fifty percent of the total display on the poster should be pictures, figures, and tables.
- Make a note at the end of the poster, "List of References available upon request with theauthor/s."
